Now the track was perfect for the amateurs, but the pros had a tuff time out there, it was a total mess. After the track was drenched with the rain it was the track was just a muddy mess that even the best riders in the nation has trouble riding.

In the 125cc main event Mike Alessi had a great battle with Davi Millsaps, they were riding neck and neck on each other but in the end Alessi won his first national race.
