## Ride Reports

### Race Report

**AWRCS round #1** at Coal Hollow was a success, especially considering the weather. The approximately 8 mile track was muddy, technical and the hills were tough. Check out the results, there were quite a few DNF's and more than a few riders with only 1 or 2 laps completed. Over 300 riders started with approx 900 total event attendance. #### **April 5, 2009 – Pirelli Big Buck GNCC – Union, SC**

The JG Off Road / GEICO Powersports / Monster Energy Kawasaki team was in Union, SC this weekend for Round #4 of the Can Am GNCC Series where Paul Whibley grabbed yet another podium finish.

Jennifer Albright had a misfire at the start, but once she got her machine running she was mid-pack heading into the woods. Jennifer put on a strong first lap, but ran into some trouble from there. Albright was a little shaken after she took on a hard hit from a nasty crash and then started having some over-heating issues with her quad. Jennifer took an 11<sup>th</sup> place class finish for the day. This finish holds Albright in 4<sup>th</sup> place in the points standings – just 2 points out of 3<sup>rd</sup>.

The XC1 boys got a good jump on the start and stayed strong throughout the course of the day. Whibley had found his way up to 2<sup>nd</sup> place by the end of the first lap and battled all day with Strang (who went down in the first turn and battled hard to the front) and Mullins. The track was a one line fast lane through the trees which made it hard on the guys to find places to pass. Jimmy Jarrett was off to a good start, in 5<sup>th</sup> place, less than 30 seconds behind the leader. Jarrett battled some mid-race arm pump that dropped him back to 11<sup>th</sup> place, but he was able to push through it and salvage a 10<sup>th</sup> place finish (18<sup>th</sup> O/A). After Round 4, Paul remains in the points lead. Jimmy Jarrett sits in 6<sup>th</sup> place, just 2 points out of the Top 5.

Scotty Watkins had a rough day from the get go, going down in the second turn off the start, he worked his way up to 5<sup>th</sup> place. Throughout the day, Watkins struggled with his suspension, which wore him down, placing him in 8<sup>th</sup> place (31<sup>st</sup> O/A) for the day. This race drops Scotty down to 5<sup>th</sup> place in the points standings, just a few points shy of cracking into the Top 3.

My passion for motorcycling and (ultimately) the motorcyclist rights movement began with my first childhood dirtbike. This same passion has infected my two nephews who received their first dirtbikes this past Christmas.

While our organization may not feel this ban's effect right now, I believe we will witness the consequences in upcoming years unless this ban is corrected. How many motorcyclists do you know whose love of motorcycling began from riding a dirtbike during their childhood? Dwindling numbers of potential street riders equates to a smaller pool of future A.B.A.T.E. members.

In the May issue of "American Motorcyclist" magazine, the AMA provided members with two pre-written postcards asking the Consumer Product Safety Commission to grant exemption for youth-sized motorcycles and ATVs. I decided to recreate the same pre-written postcards to distribute at tomorrow night's Allegheny County Chapter meeting.

**Please carefully read the following. It is a serious and binding legal contract.**

I, on behalf of myself, my heirs, executors, successors, administrators, assigns, personal representatives, next of kin, and estate, and, if applicable, as parent or guardian of a member or other minor participant under the age of 18, and their heirs, executors, successors, administrators, assigns, personal representatives, next of kin, and estate, AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. I acknowledge, understand, and appreciate that off-road motorcycle and ATV riding is a hazardous and very dangerous activity with inherent and other risks of serious personal injury, death, and property damage. I voluntarily and knowingly assume full responsibility

for all these risks and dangers arising from or related to participation in any Three Rivers Competition Riders (hereinafter "TRCR") sponsored, coordinated, or organized event, activity, meeting, or party, including the negligence of others and negligent rescue operations.

2. I release, discharge, agree to hold harmless, covenant not to sue or file a lawsuit against, and waive any claim or cause of action against TRCR, its officers, directors, trail leaders and members, and their heirs, executors, successors, administrators, assigns, personal representatives, next of kin, and estates, from and for any and all losses, injuries, claims, costs, attorney's fees, expert's fees, court costs, causes of action, liabilities, judgments, or damages of any type or kind, even if any of the above persons or entities are or are alleged to be negligent (whether solely, partially, concurrently, actively, or passively) or otherwise at fault in any way, on account of any personal injury, death, or property damage which may result, directly or indirectly, from my participation in any TRCR sponsored, coordinated, or organized event, activity, meeting, or party.
3. I agree to FULLY DEFEND AND INDEMNIFY TRCR, its officers, directors, trail leaders and members, and their heirs, executors, successors, administrators, assigns, personal representatives, next of kin, and estates, from and against any and all losses, injuries, claims, costs, attorney's fees, expert's fees, court costs, causes of action, liabilities, judgments, or damages of any type or kind, even if any of the above persons or entities are or are alleged to be negligent (whether solely, partially, or concurrently), or otherwise at fault in any way, on account of any personal injury, death, or property damage which may result, directly or indirectly, from my participation in any TRCR sponsored, coordinated, or organized event, activity, meeting, or party.
4. I agree to follow sensible trail riding principles and ride carefully to ensure my own safety as well as the safety of those with whom I share the trail.
5. I hereby consent to and permit first aid and emergency medical treatment if I am injured.
6. I hereby acknowledge that TRCR is an off-road vehicle club which is dedicated to the furtherance and preservation of the sport. I therefore agree to follow general rules of good conduct and sensible behavior at all club functions and wherever TRCR appears in public in any way.
7. Photocopies, fax copies, or electronic/pdf copies of this signed document are just as enforceable as the original.
